Fuel cells could reduce CO2 emissions by 50 percent (Jul 15 2003 04:46 GMT)

- [6.13.2003] A study by the environmental group WWF and Fuel Cell Europe has shown that carbon dioxide emissions from fossil fuel power plants in Europe could be cut by 50% if electricity and heat were supplied by fuel cells. The study also pointed out the economic benefits of a fuel cell industry providing distributed power and heat. Mitsubishi recently released a new 1kW home fuel cell that is roughly half the size of the previous model, standing at about 3 feet or 1 meter tall (japanese version of the release).

- [6.11.2003] In his testimony to the House Energy and Commerce Committee yesterday, Fed chairman Alan Greenspan warned that higher natural gas prices would continue into 2004. The problem is that while gas used to be a cyclical commodity, many gas fired plants have been built, driving demand up. Gas used to be bought and stored away in the summer

when demand was low and prices were cheaper.

- [6.5.2003] The Wall Street Journal had an article on the front page of Wednesday's edition that discussed the hazards surrounding abandoned coal mines, including coal mine fires, acid mine drainage, and accidents involving open mine shafts. A 1977 law imposes production fees on active coal mining operations, which are deposited in the Abandoned Mine Reclamation Fund. This fund is used to pay the reclamation costs of abandoned mine land projects.

- [6.4.2003] The US Senate is debating its version of the new energy bill and has voted down 3 anti-ethanol proposals, paving the way for ethanol to be used as a gasoline additive (replacing MTBE in many states). The Senate bill matches the House version of the energy bill on ethanol and renewable fuels use, both proposing a mandate of 5 billion gallons of renewable fuel by 2012. More ethanol is good news to corn growers and will reduce emissions somewhat, but ethanol does have its problems.
